1. Indicative Transaction Documentation Framework

Stage 1 – Pre-Contractual & Counterparty Verification

Indicative documentation at this stage may include corporate identification materials, counterparty verification and compliance screening records, and indicative statements relating to product availability.

Stage 2 – Contractual Alignment & Transaction Structuring

Documentation at this stage may include the executed Sales and Purchase Agreement (SPA), definition of delivery terms (FOB or CIF), and agreement on inspection scope, logistics structure, and payment instruments.

Stage 3 – Operational & Quality Assurance Documentation

Issued strictly in accordance with the SPA, documentation at this stage may include quality and quantity verification frameworks and independent inspection arrangements.

Stage 4 – Delivery, Title Transfer & Post-Execution

Documentation at this stage may include delivery confirmation aligned with applicable Incoterms and post-execution compliance record retention.
